MINUTES

The following members were present: Mayor Bill Schickel in the chair; Doug Campbell, and Jacob Schweitzer representing the Mason City Board of Education; Paul Adams, Josh Masson, and Will Symonds representing the Mason City City Council; and Casey Callanan, Tim Latham and Chris Watts representing the Cerro Gordo County Board of Supervisors. Also present was Dana Shipley, Mason City Assessor, acting as clerk; and Tara Fitzpatrick, Mason City Chief Deputy Assessor.

It was moved by Mr. Latham and seconded by Mr. Adams to adopt the meeting agenda. All ayes, motion carried. It was moved by Mr. Schweitzer and seconded by Mr. Callanan. All ayes, motion carried.

The floor was opened for public input. There being no public present, it was moved by Mr. Callanan, seconded by Mr. Masson to close the public hearing on the City Assessor Budget. All ayes, motion carried.

Supervisors: Callanan voted aye. Latham voted aye. Watts voted aye.

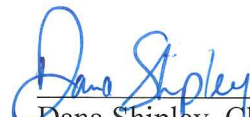
City Council: Masson voted aye. Symonds voted aye. Adams voted aye.
